- Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**
- Provide door-through-door service
- Time Commitment:**
- Attend a two (2) hour training course
 - Attend quarterly & annual meetings (30 minutes to an hour)
 - Volunteer a minimum of three (3) hours per month
- Qualifications:**
- Must have a valid driver's license
 - Must be at least 21 years old
 - Must be able to pass a background check
 - Must attend a training class
 - Must have clean driving record
 - Must have his/her own auto insurance
 - Additional insurance provided
- Support Provided:**
- Volunteers are asked to commit three hours per month to drive an older adult on an essential trip within the county they volunteer in (currently we are in Putnam, Cumberland, and Warren Counties). More donated time is encouraged, but not required.
 - MyRide has purchased excess auto, medical, and liability insurance for all volunteers. The volunteer's auto insurance is always primary. Finally, both state and federal volunteer protection laws offer another layer of safety for volunteers.
